



BRUSH PEN CALLIGRAPHY SUPPLIES

1. Dot Grid pad for practice (Rhodia or any similar brand)
2. Tombow Fudenosuke Brush pen (Soft tip) OR Pentel Fude Touch Brush pen (Black)
3. HB pencil for warmups and drills
4. A4 size printer paper
5. Layout paper for tracing (optional)
6. Card stock and other coloured papers for finished pieces

Frequently asked questions

Which pen is right for me?

There are several types of brush pens available in the market. Over the years I have tried various pens and nibs for my Calligraphy practice, in the hope of finding the perfect one. The choice of pen depends a lot on the desired end result, the level of expertise as well as your writing style.

One of the main considerations while choosing a brush pen is the elasticity of the tip, which determines its ability to bounce back to a fine point. For a complete beginner, the Fudenosuke pen with a soft tip (Tombow or Pentel) is probably the best. Once you become comfortable with the technique and the pressure you apply, you can experiment with more flexible brush pens.
